## A Rare Historic Collection in Landscape Artistry

With the many years of experience creating beautiful private and public gardens, restaurants, hotels, resorts and many other diverse environments, Enea revealed a mystical space exhibiting century year old trees. A distinguished tree collector of rare trees from all over the world, Enzo Enea dedicated a Tree Museum on 75,000 square meters of land near Upper Lake Zurich, Switzerland.

As visitors step foot into the Tree Museum, a tranquil aura is felt in every inch of this massive space where each tree is showcased in such delicate fashion.

Enea was able to share his passion with trees to the world in modern architecture style by building open-air "spaces" that are separated into a number of rooms, each with its own atmosphere and character. This method is a characteristic done in all of Enea gardens thus allowing every tree to be singled out and to become individual where the limelight is shone only on its beauty and history. The Museum will display around fifty trees of more than twenty-five species that are over a hundred years old. Some of those trees featured for viewing are: a 130 years old Red Japanese Maple (Acer palmatum "Dissectum Atropurpureum"), a 60 years old Japanese Maple (Acer palmatum), a Saucer Magnolia (Magnolia soulangeana) about 80 years old, a Persian Irontree (Parrotia persica) about 70 years old, a Fullmoon Maple (Acer japonicum "Aconitifolium") - between 40 to 50 years old, a Field Elm (Ulmus minor) that is about 40 years old and an 80 year old English Yew (Taxus baccata). •
